ART VISION

The NFTs in the Rotten Gary Collection are handcrafted with great attention to detail using artificial intelligence designed prompts, some human color and element correction and human fully crafting of elements.

The colors and models used in the scenery are intended to give a perspective of a grunge and rotten world in which Gary disinvolves.

The background elements have been carefully selected and placed to build up the stage of the intimacy of the character, but at the same time, scramble the idea of a "logical" room. The viewer may find pieces of a bathroom and tables with food, but it's hard to understand where Gary is located.

The collection aims to shed light on the political context of the lawsuit from United States regulators on Ripple by providing subtle hints and clues throughout the art. At the same time, it aims to offer a satirical commentary on the absurdity of the topic by incorporating elements of humor and irony. Through the use of witty and cleverly crafted comedic elements, the collection seeks to convey a nuanced and thought-provoking message that offers a fresh perspective on the subject matter.

Certain elements of the collection possess a historical subtext that necessitates a certain level of familiarity with the topic at hand, yet they are crafted in such a way that they will still resonate with those who may not possess such knowledge. The collection's distinct characteristics are a result of these elements, as well as the deliberate manipulation of Gary's attire, which serves as a commentary that is independent of the primary narrative and just tries to give Gary a "character" personality.

The intention is to provide the viewer with a more approachable and digestible perspective on complex politics.

UTILITY VISION

The plan for this collection is to create pieces that can transcend the time of XRPL as one of the first "serious" collections that dealt with the topic of the SEC lawsuit against Ripple.

We understand art and comedy as a means of free expression to share ideas, perspectives, and opinions. Therefore, the ultimate utility of this collection will always be to resonate in the real world and generate an impact on the XRPL community and beyond, as a medium for expression.

The speculative value that Rotten Gary can attain will be contingent upon the community's perception. Nevertheless, our brand and the artists will impart real utility to the possession of the NFTs through the provision of exclusive privileges and access within the Unflake ecosystem for the owners of each piece.

The collection has two tangible goals. The first is for David Swartz to accept a piece of the collection as a gift. The second is to write a letter with comments from each of the holders to send directly to the current director of the Securities and Exchange Commission.

Efforts will be made to present certain items from the collection to influential individuals within the XRP Ledger community, with the intent of creating a greater impact and resonance within the blockchain community.

THE LETTER MECHANISM:

We have a draft of a letter that we will put up for "review" with the community of holders. The idea is to achieve, among all of us, the addition of comments to it before sending it. Additionally, part of the royalties will be used to print the letter on metal, frame it, and send it so they can hang this nice memory in the SEC offices. We'll probably need to think of some additional mechanisms to achieve this, but we'll do it on the go

THE LETTER DRAFT

Dear Gary:

Although in recent years you have become the number one enemy of those who use XRPL to preserve, transfer, and exchange value, we understand that your position, motives, and actions have reasons that go beyond harming us. Therefore, we will not judge you on a human level.

We understand that the government institutions in the United States are constrained, bound, and often backed against a wall by unseen academic, corporate, and political actors. We know that the pressures and amount of interests are many, and that sometimes officials in these institutions are only fulfilling their day-to-day work, but deep down they are not doing what they believe.

We do not pity you, you have been a recognized academic in the United States for your deep knowledge of new economic technologies and we are sure that you understand the potential of XRPL to solve problems such as remittance transactions, the speed and reliability of interbank record-keeping, efficient energy use to not affect the environment among many others.

We don't know the background of your decisions, nor do we know if they are actually your decisions or those of others who have power over you. Even though we do not judge you as a human being, as citizens of the world, we can judge your political actions.

As much as you try to affect Ripple, XRPL doesn't belong to them anymore. We are hundreds of thousands of citizens around the world who maintain a consensus of using the network and that despite any regulations imposed by any government around the world, will not end our freedom to decide where and how to place our values, who to trust and how much risk we're willing to take.

You should know that attempts at regulation can never stand up against the power of the free market. The market self-regulates and always finds ways to meet the natural forces of demand. We believe that it is appropriate to establish rules among economic actors, however, when these rules affect the origin of demand - the consumers - governments only awaken forces that are greater than them.
